Diamond Ventures Donates Land to United Community Health Center
Enables Expansion of United Community Health Center Campus and Programs

GREEN VALLEY, Ariz. (January 18, 2008) – Diamond Ventures, United Community Health Center (UCHC) and officials from state and local government announced today Diamond Ventures' land gift to UCHC, enabling the center to expand the Continental Family Medical Center clinic located at 1260 S. Campbell Road in Green Valley, Ariz.

"This area of Greater Tucson has needed to expand its healthcare programs for children and retirees specifically," said Kenneth Abrahams, executive vice president of Diamond Ventures. "It is vital to the community that the facility have more room for its patients, which the land donation will help UCHC do.

With the Continental Family Medical Center clinic being located on land previously donated from Diamond Ventures, The additional land donation will enable us to expand the existing facility and allow us to immediately begin our fundraising activities."

Russ Symes, president of the Green Valley Community Coordinating Council said that the new facility will represent a solution found through the giving and coordination of public groups and citizens.

"Diamond Ventures, UCHC and local government departments have collaborated well and worked hard to ensure the people here are provided for," Symes said.
